14 A'kin Cellular Radiance Serum (\$40). This silky, organic serum ticks all the boxes: omega-3, 6 and 9 essential fatty acids strengthen cell walls by controlling moisture loss; antioxidants battle skin-damaging free radicals; and Vitamins E and A help to reduce the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles. Wear it alone or under moisturiser.

15 John Plunkett Superfade Face Cream (\$30). This comes from Plunkett Pharmaceuticals, founded more than 25 years ago by pharmacist John Plunkett and now the market leader in anti-pigmentation products. This wonder-worker relies on hydroquinone, the main whitening ingredient found in prescription products, and the company claims an 80-per-cent success rate in treating pigmentation problems.

16 Ultracuticals Ultra A Eye Cream (\$85). Founded by Dr Geoffrey Heber, a Sydney cosmetic physician, Ultracuticals is one of the best-selling Australian skincare brands in David Jones, and for good reason – its products really work. This newcomer to the range is high in retinol and very effective for reducing the appearance of fine lines and photo-ageing around the eyes.

17 Sukin Moisture Restoring Night Cream (\$20). Night creams can be expensive, but not this award-winner. A blend of rosehip, evening primrose oil, borage and aloe vera, it helps to repair and hydrate skin overnight. Good for the neck and décolletage, too.

18 Jurlique Herbal Recovery Gel (from \$70). This powerhouse performer has been around for 25 years and is still one of Jurlique's top sellers. Deeply hydrating and fast-absorbing, it revitalises the skin to make it look healthier and more radiant.

19 Kosmea Skin Clinic Certified 100% Organic Rose Hip Oil (from \$25). The cornerstone of the Kosmea brand, launched in Adelaide in 1994, and one of the most powerful rosehip oils available. Just three to four drops of this extra-light treatment will fend off almost every sign of ageing.

20 Invisible Zinc Environmental Skin Protector SPF30+ (from \$25). A cult favourite worldwide, this product provides the ultimate protection against facial sun damage, thanks to a patented type of zinc oxide that acts as a physical – not chemical – barrier against both UVB and deeper-penetrating, even more ageing UVA rays.
